ORDINANCE # 7-SECTION 29USE OF ROLLER SKATES, SKATEBOARDS, BICYCLES, COASTERS, ETC., ON
ROADWAYS AND SIDEWALKS.

No person upon or riding upon any roller skates, skateboard, toy vehicle, coaster or similar device shall go upon any street or roadway with the city, except while crossing a street at a designated crosswalk or at the intersection of streets. Within the central business district area as defined by boundaries of North-McFarland street, South-Vernon street, East-Jernigan street and West-Branch street, no person upon or riding any roller skates, skateboard, toy vehicle, coaster or similar device shall go upon any sidewalk or driveway; provided however, nothing herein is intended to prevent the city council from granting specific exemptions for planned special events.



ORDINANCE NO. 7 - section 29

USE OF ROLLER SKATES, COASTERS, ETC., ON ROADWAY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BELLS, TEXAS, THAT:

No person on roller skates, or riding in or by means of any
coaster, skate board, toy vehicle or similar device shall go
upon any roadway, except while crossing a street or a crosswalk,
and when so crossing, such person shall be granted all of the
rights and be subject to all of the duties applicable to pedestrians.
