

ORDINANCE NO. 9 - section 29

STOP INTERSECTIONS AND THROUGH STREETS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLS, TEXAS, THAT:

The city council may designate any street intersection as a stop intersection and designate the streets upon which vehicles shall stop before entering such intersection. The council may likewise designate through streets on which the drivers of vehicles shall have the right-of-way over vehicles approaching on another street. Whenever any intersection or through street has been so designated, the mayor shall so cause the same to be indetified by the erection of stop signs indicating which vehicles approaching the intersection shall stop, and it shall be the duty of the driver of any vehicle approaching such a sign to bring such vehicle to a complete stop at such sign or a clearly marked stop line before entering the intersection, except when directed to proceed by a police officer or a traffic-control signal. After having so stopped, such driver shall yield the right-of-way to other vehicles which have entered the intersection or which are approaching so closely as to constitute an immediate hazard. Such driver, after having so yielded, may proceed and the drivers of all other vehicles approaching on the intersecting street shall yield the right-of-way to the vehicle so proceeding into or across the intersection.
