

ORDINANCE NO. 97-106

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CITY OF BELLS, TEXAS, CEMETERIES, SPECIFICALLY, ROSEHILL CEMETERY, EDNA EVERHEART ADDITION OF ROSEHILL CEMETERY AND THE CEMETERY KNOWN AS NORTH CEMETERY, EACH BEING THE PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF BELLS, TEXAS, WHICH HAVE BEEN OPERATED AS PERPETUAL CARE CEMETERIES, AND NOW ADOPT CHAPTER 713, LOCAL REGULATION OF CEMETERIES, ARTICLE 713.001 AND ARTICLE 713.002 OF THE VERNON'S TEXAS ANNOTATED CODE OF HEALTH AND SAFETY.

WHEREAS, the need exists to continue operating ROSEHILL CEMETERY, EDNA EVERHEART ADDITION OF ROSEHILL CEMETERY and the cemetery known as NORTH CEMETERY, as perpetual care cemeteries, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bells, Texas, after due study, desires implementing a permanent perpetual care cemetery, and

WHEREAS, it is in the present and long-term interest of the City of Bells, Texas, to adopt Chapter 713, Local Regulation of Cemeteries, Subchapter A, Article 713.001 and Article 713.002 and subsequent sections of the Vernon's Texas Annotated Code of Health and Safety;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bells, Grayson County, Texas, that they choose to operate the cemetery properties under Chapter 713, Local Regulation of Cemeteries, Subchapter A, Article 713.001 and Article 713.002 and subsequent sections of the Vernon's Texas Annotated Code of Health and Safety, and may act as permanent Trustees for the perpetual maintenance of lots and graves in the cemeteries, and this is the intent of the City of Bells to operate as Trustee and the Trust is to be perpetual.
