

Ordinance 99-0907A

Municipal Court Building Security Fund

An Ordinance Authorizing the Bells Municipal Court to collect a special fee from defendants convicted of a misdemeanor offense in a Municipal Court in accordance to Article 102.017 of the Code of Criminal Procedure


Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Bells;

1. That the Bells Municipal Court is hereby authorized to collect a special Administrative fee not to exceed Three Dollars (\$3.00) from each defendant convicted of a misdemeanor offense in Municipal Court in accordance to Article 102.107(d); Court Costs; courthouse security fund; municipal court building security fund., Texas Code of Criminal Procedure


2. The Municipal Court must collect those fees and pay those fees to the municipal treasurer, or to any other official who performs those duties. The fund shall be administered by the municipality's governing body. The fund shall be used only to purchase or to finance the following items when used for the purpose of providing security services for buildings housing a district, county, justice, or municipal court, as appropriate: (1) the purchase or repair of X-ray machines and conveying systems; (2) hand held metal detectors; (3) walk through metal detectors; (4) identification cards and systems; (5) electronic locking and surveillance equipment; (6) bailiffs, deputy sheriffs, deputy constables, or contract security personnel during times when they are providing appropriate security services; (7) signage; (8) confiscated weapon inventory and tracking systems; (9) locks, chains, or other security hardware; or (10) continuing education on security issues for court personnel and security personnel; (11) purchase or repair of bullet proof glass (12) the purchase of alarms or similar security devices

3. This fee is applied to the cost, on conviction, for an offense committed on or after September 1, 1999.
