Ordinance 99-0907B

Municipal Court Technology Fund

An Ordinance Authorizing the Bells Municipal Court to collect a special fee from defendants convicted of a misdemeanor offense in a Municipal Court in accordance to Article 102.0172 of the Code of Criminal Procedure


Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Bells;

1. That the Bells Municipal Court is hereby authorized to collect a special Administrative fee not to exceed Four Dollars (\$4.00) from each defendant convicted of a misdemeanor offense in Municipal Court in accordance to Article 102.1072; Court Costs; municipal court technology fund., Texas Code of Criminal Procedure

2. The Municipal Court must collect those fees and pay those fees to the municipal treasurer, or to any other official who performs those duties. The fund shall be administered by the municipality's governing body. The fund shall be used only to purchase technological enhancements including: (1) Computer systems, (2) Computer networks, (3) Computer hardware, (4) Computer software, (5) Imaging systems, (6) Electronic kiosks, (7) Electronic ticket writers, and (8) Docket management systems, for the efficiency of the court.

3. This fee is applied to the cost, on conviction, for an offense committed on or after September 1, 1999. **The provisions added by this ordinance will expire on September 1, 2005.**
