Dear Bells Residents,

We would like to take this opportunity to thank all of you for your business. We continue to strive to offer the most dependable sanitation services in the Northeast-Texas area. As some of you are aware, we have had some communication problems with Bulky Waste Collection Services.

I met with the City Councilmembers last night on the date of August 18, 2014 and agreed to the changes listed below about Bulky Waste Collection.

The City of Bells has agreed to change its Bulky Waste Collection schedule to the last collection day of each month. The resident must contact Sanitation Solutions at (903) 784-0124 to schedule the pickup at least 24-hours prior to the collection day.

On the last collection day of each month, residents can place Two (2) Bulky Waste Items or Four (4) cubic yards of bagged or bundled material neatly stacked at the curb one (1) day prior to their scheduled pickup day. Bulky Waste items should be placed curbside by 7:00AM of their designated collection day. Loose Bulky Waste items must be contained, tied, or bundled to be collected with the normal solid waste collection.

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

Bulky Waste items consist of Stoves, Refrigerators (with all CFC removed/ requires written documentation), Water Tanks, Washing Machines, Furniture, and any other similar items, and materials that are not prohibited.

Bulky Waste items that ARE NOT ACCEPTED are as follows – Batteries, 55-Gallon Barrels, Concrete, Construction Debris, Large Dead Animals, Fence Posts or Fencing Materials, Hazardous Waste, Liquids or Paint, Propane Tanks, Tires, or Stable Matter, with weights or volumes greater than those allowed for the weight restriction clause (one time per month/ limit 2 items).

Bulky Waste can be placed out as early as 4:00PM the day before the scheduled collection, but no later than 7:00AM on the day of collection.
